## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the week of April 7, 2003, as "Rural Road Safety Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Agriculture is Pennsylvania's number one industry;
4	and
5	WHEREAS, Agriculture is dependent on the movement of farm
6	equipment on rural roads in this Commonwealth; and
7	WHEREAS, Farm equipment travels at slower speeds than other
8	traffic and is often wider than other vehicles; and
9	WHEREAS, Operators of farm equipment are not always aware of
10	their duties when operating those vehicles on roads; and
11	WHEREAS, Many drivers are not aware of the possible presence

of farm equipment on roads and the precautions that should be
taken on roads occupied by farm equipment; and

3 WHEREAS, The number of drivers on rural roads in this

4 Commonwealth is increasing; and

5 WHEREAS, It is the intent of the agricultural community to 6 raise awareness of the use of farm equipment on roads; therefore 7 be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the9 week of April 7, 2003, as "Rural Road Safety Week" in

10 Pennsylvania.
