A RESOLUTION

- 1 Observing the week of June 1 through 8, 2003, as "National
- 2 Fishing Week" in this Commonwealth.
- 3 WHEREAS, Fishing is an outdoor tradition rooted deeply in the
- 4 history of our State and its citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Each year, 1.3 million Pennsylvanians fish
- 6 Commonwealth waters, making more than 18 million trips to those
- 7 waters; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The sport of fishing not only provides wholesome
- 9 recreational opportunities but also contributes some \$1.1
- 10 billion of economic input to this Commonwealth, supports more
- 11 than 14,000 jobs for Pennsylvanians and contributes about \$54
- 12 million to the General Fund in State sales and income taxes; and
- 13 WHEREAS, "National Fishing Week," June 1 through 8, 2003, is
- 14 a cooperative program designed to promote recreational fishing
- 15 and aquatic resource education in the United States; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In conjunction with "National Fishing Week," the
- 17 Commonwealth has marked June 7, 2003, as "Fish for Free Day";

- 2 WHEREAS, "Fish for Free Day" provides all Pennsylvanians with
- 3 an opportunity to sample this Commonwealth's plentiful fishing
- 4 opportunities without a fishing license; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the week of June 1 through 8, 2003, be
- 6 observed as "National Fishing Week" in this Commonwealth.
