AN ACT

- Designating a portion of State Route 23 in Lancaster County as the Representative Leroy M. Zimmerman Memorial Highway.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Representative Leroy M. Zimmerman Memorial Highway.
- 6 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly hereby finds and
- 7 declares as follows:
- 8 (1) Representative Leroy M. Zimmerman (1932-2002) served
- 9 in the General Assembly from 1994 through December 2002,
- 10 having been elected to four consecutive terms as a State
- 11 Representative.
- 12 (2) Along with his many years of service to the
- Commonwealth, Representative Zimmerman was also a respected
- farmer who served the agricultural community as well as an
- active member of the Northeast Poultry Council, the National
- 16 Turkey Federation, the Pennsylvania State University Poultry
- 17 Science Council and the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau.

- 1 (3) Representative Zimmerman will be remembered for his
- devoted 34 years of service to the residents of Lancaster
- 3 County, serving as a Republican committeeman, East Earl
- 4 Township Supervisor and a State Representative.
- 5 (b) Designation authorized. -- The portion of State Route 23
- 6 between the western boundary of Earl Township in Lancaster
- 7 County and the Berks County line is hereby designated and shall
- 8 be known as the Representative Leroy M. Zimmerman Memorial
- 9 Highway.
- 10 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 11 maintain appropriate signs, which shall display the name of the
- 12 highway designated in subsection (b), at each end of the named
- 13 segment.
- 14 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
