- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for certain veterans plates; and further
- 3 providing for permit for movement of containerized cargo.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
- 8 § 1362. Operation Iraqi Freedom veterans plate.
- 9 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the
- 10 liberation or occupation of Iraq, accompanied by a fee of \$20,
- 11 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by
- 12 documentation as the department shall require, the department
- 13 shall issue to the person a special registration plate

- 1 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
- 2 is a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
- 3 § 1363. Operation Enduring Freedom veterans plate.
- 4 <u>Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the</u>
- 5 <u>liberation or occupation of Afghanistan, accompanied by a fee of</u>
- 6 \$20, which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee
- 7 and by documentation as the department shall require, the
- 8 <u>department shall issue to the person a special registration</u>
- 9 plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a
- 10 person who is a veteran of Operation Enduring Freedom.
- 11 § 1364. Special plates for veterans.
- 12 <u>Upon application of any person who is an honorably discharged</u>
- 13 <u>veteran of the armed forces of the United States, or a reserve</u>
- 14 component of the armed forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301
- 15 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of \$20 which
- 16 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such
- 17 documentation as the department shall require, the department
- 18 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
- 19 <u>designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a</u>
- 20 veteran of the armed forces of the United States.
- 21 Section 2. Section 4974 of Title 75 is amended to read:
- 22 \ \ 4974. Permit for movement of containerized cargo.
- 23 (a) General rule. An annual permit may be issued
- 24 authorizing the movement on highways of containerized cargo
- 25 which exceeds the maximum vehicle gross or maximum axle weights

- 26 specified in Subchapter C (relating to maximum weights of
- 27 vehicles). [The] Except as set forth in subsection (b), the
- 28 weight of any combination permitted under this section shall not
- 29 exceed 90,000 pounds overall gross weight and 21,000 pounds on
- 30 any axle. A brake retarder is not required on a combination

- 1 permitted under this section while the combination is operated
- 2 within the counties which comprise the district of a port of a
- 3 city of the first class. A vehicle operating under a permit
- 4 authorized under this section may be driven 24 hours a day,
- 5 seven days a week, except on holidays and in inclement weather.
- 6 (b) Refrigerated meat products. A combination of vehicles
- 7 which is hauling refrigerated meat products to or from a port of
- 8 <u>a city of the first class may be permitted by the department and</u>
- 9 <u>local authorities to move upon highways within their respective</u>
- 10 jurisdictions 24 hours a day, seven days a week, if the gross
- 11 weight does not exceed 110,000 pounds and if the weight of any
- 12 <u>nonsteering axle does not exceed 21,000 pounds.</u>
- 13 § 4974. PERMIT FOR MOVEMENT OF CONTAINERIZED CARGO.
- 14 (A) GENERAL RULE. -- AN ANNUAL PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED
- 15 AUTHORIZING THE MOVEMENT ON HIGHWAYS OF CONTAINERIZED CARGO
- 16 WHICH EXCEEDS THE MAXIMUM VEHICLE GROSS OR MAXIMUM AXLE WEIGHTS
- 17 SPECIFIED IN SUBCHAPTER C (RELATING TO MAXIMUM WEIGHTS OF
- 18 VEHICLES). [THE] EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (B), THE
- 19 WEIGHT OF ANY COMBINATION PERMITTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOT
- 20 EXCEED 90,000 POUNDS OVERALL GROSS WEIGHT AND 21,000 POUNDS ON
- 21 ANY AXLE. A BRAKE RETARDER IS NOT REQUIRED ON A COMBINATION
- 22 PERMITTED UNDER THIS SECTION WHILE THE COMBINATION IS OPERATED
- 23 WITHIN THE COUNTIES [WHICH COMPRISE THE DISTRICT OF A PORT OF A
- 24 CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS.] OF BUCKS, CHESTER, DELAWARE,
- 25 MONTGOMERY AND PHILADELPHIA. A VEHICLE OPERATING UNDER A PERMIT
- 26 AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE DRIVEN 24 HOURS A DAY,
- 27 SEVEN DAYS A WEEK, EXCEPT ON HOLIDAYS AND IN INCLEMENT WEATHER.
- 28 (B) REFRIGERATED MEAT PRODUCTS. -- AN ANNUAL PERMIT MAY BE
- 29 <u>ISSUED AUTHORIZING THE MOVEMENT ON SPECIFIED HIGHWAYS OF</u>
- 30 CONTAINERIZED CARGO CONSISTING OF REFRIGERATED MEAT PRODUCTS

- 1 WHICH EXCEEDS THE MAXIMUM VEHICLE GROSS WEIGHT OR MAXIMUM AXLE
- 2 WEIGHTS SPECIFIED IN SUBCHAPTER C, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING
- 3 CONDITIONS:
- 4 (1) THE VEHICLE MUST BE A SIX-AXLE COMBINATION THREE-
- 5 AXLE TRUCK TRACTOR.
- 6 (2) GROSS VEHICULAR WEIGHT MUST NOT EXCEED 107,500
- 7 POUNDS.
- 8 (3) MAXIMUM WEIGHT ON ANY AXLE MUST NOT EXCEED 21,000
- 9 <u>POUNDS</u>.
- 10 (4) SPECIFIED HIGHWAYS AND ROUTES MAY ONLY BE PERMITTED
- 11 <u>IN THE COUNTIES OF BUCKS, CHESTER, DELAWARE, MONTGOMERY AND</u>
- 12 <u>PHILADELPHIA</u>.
- 13 (5) TRAVEL IS AUTHORIZED 24 HOURS A DAY, SEVEN DAYS A
- 14 WEEK, EXCEPT ON HOLIDAYS AND IN INCLEMENT WEATHER.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
