- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 - Statutes, further providing for general requirements for
- 3 school buses.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4552 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 4552. General requirements for school buses.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (b.4) Use of seat check reminder device. -- Every school bus
- 11 shall be equipped with a seat check reminder device of a type
- 12 that has been approved by regulation adopted by the department.
- 13 The device shall be mounted in the inside rear of the bus and
- 14 shall be activated when the vehicle ignition is turned to the
- 15 off position. The seat check reminder device is mandated
- 16 according to the following schedule:

- 1 (1) School buses may be equipped with and use an
- approved seat check reminder device on January 1, 2006. 2
- 3 (2) Every school bus purchased and manufactured after
- January 1, 2006, shall be equipped with an approved seat 4
- 5 check reminder device.
- (3) By September 1, 2006, every school bus shall be 6
- equipped with an approved seat check reminder device. 7

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 9
