AN ACT

1 Providing for visibility of child safety warnings.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. General rule.

5 A safety warning on a child safety seat, toy or other device
6 must be placed on the device in such a manner as to make the
7 warning clearly visible. The warning must be in English in
8 letters sufficiently large to be easily read, and written in
9 such a manner as to be readily understandable.

10 Section 2. Grounds for civil action.

11 Failure of a safety warning on a child safety seat, toy or
12 other device to meet the requirements of section 1 (relating to
13 general rule) may be used as evidence against the manufacturer
14 or seller of the device in a civil action based on injury or
15 death of a child.

16 Section 3. Effective date.

17 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
