AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto;" requiring a school district
6 representative on a charter school board of trustees.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1715-A(11) of the act of March 10, 1949
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
11 amended to read:

12 Section 1715-A. Charter School Requirements.--Charter
13 schools shall be required to comply with the following
14 provisions:

15 * * *

16 (11) Trustees of a charter school shall be public officials.
17 One member of the board of trustees shall be a representative of
18 the school district in which the charter school is located.
19 There shall be an additional member of the board of trustees for

1 each school district from which twenty percent (20%) or more of
2 its students attending the charter school reside.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
