AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled 2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 7 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," further providing for the date of the general 11 12 primary.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 14
- 15 Section 1. Section 603(a) of the act of June 3, 1937
- 16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,
- amended November 24, 1999 (P.L.543, No.51), is amended to read: 17
- 18 Section 603. General Primary; Candidates to Be Nominated and
- Party Officers to Be Elected. -- (a) There shall be a General 19
- primary preceding each general election which shall be held on 20
- 21 the third Tuesday of [May in all even-numbered years, except in

- 1 the year of the nomination of a President of the United States,
- 2 in which year the General primary shall be held on the fourth
- 3 Tuesday of April] March. Candidates for all offices to be filled
- 4 at the ensuing general election shall be nominated at the
- 5 General primary. The vote for candidates for the office of
- 6 President of the United States, as provided for by this act,
- 7 shall be cast at the General primary.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
