AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for unlawful devices and methods.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 2308(b) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 2308. Unlawful devices and methods.
- 8 * * *
- 9 (b) Exceptions. -- The provisions of subsection (a) shall not
- 10 apply to:
- 11 (1) Any archery sight or firearm's scope which contains
- 12 and uses any mechanical, photoelectric, ultraviolet or solar-
- powered device to solely illuminate the sight or crosshairs
- 14 within the scope. No archery sight or firearm's scope shall
- 15 contain or use any device, no matter how powered, to project
- or transmit any light beam, infrared beam, ultraviolet light
