## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for special tax provisions relating to land conservation.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
б	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 2(b) of Article VIII be amended by adding a
9	clause to read:
10	§ 2. Exemptions and special provisions.

12	(b) The General Assembly may, by law:

14	(vii) Establish standards and qualifications for State tax

<u>credits for persons who grant fee simple or other titled</u>
<u>interests in forest, agricultural and other open space lands, to</u>
<u>governmental or charitable entities for purposes of</u>
conservation.

6 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 7 8 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 9 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 10 11 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 12 13 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

14 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) 15 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 16 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 17 18 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 19 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 20 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 21 22 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 23 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first primary, general or municipal election which meets the 24 25 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 26 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 27 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 28 passed by the General Assembly.

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
