- 1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled
- 2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration
- thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery
- 4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of

- 7 further defining "eligible claimant."
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The definition of "eligible claimant" in section
- 11 502 of the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the
- 12 State Lottery Law, added November 21, 1996 (P.L.741, No.134), is
- 13 amended to read:

- 2 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 3 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 4 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 6 "Eligible claimant." A resident of the Commonwealth for no
- 7 less than 90 days, who is [65] 60 years of age and over, whose
- 8 annual income is less than the maximum annual income and who is
- 9 not otherwise qualified for public assistance under the act of
- 10 June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code.

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
