## AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled 2
  - "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration
- 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery
- Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of
- funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes
- from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"
- 7 further providing for Federal programs.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 2103 of the act of August 26, 1971
- (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, added November 11
- 12 26, 2003 (P.L.212, No.37), is amended to read:
- Section 2103. Federal programs. 13
- 14 (a) General rule. -- If the Federal Government enacts programs
- 15 similar to PACE or PACENET, the State programs shall be
- 16 construed to only supplement the Federal programs, and all
- persons qualified for coverage under the Federal program shall 17

- 1 utilize that Federal program before utilizing any State program.
- 2 (b) Deposit of revenues. -- Any revenues received by the
- 3 Commonwealth as a direct result of the enactment of any Federal
- 4 Government program similar to PACE or PACENET shall be deposited
- 5 <u>in the State Lottery Fund to be utilized to further supplement</u>
- 6 programs that benefit Pennsylvanians who are 65 years of age or
- 7 <u>older.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
