AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), entitled
 "An act relating to unfair insurance practices; prohibiting
 unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts
 and practices; and prescribing remedies and penalties,"
 further defining "unfair methods of competition" and "unfair
 or deceptive acts or practices."
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of July 22, 1974
- 10 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act,
- 11 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 12 Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or
- 13 Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined.--(a) "Unfair methods of
- 14 competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" in the
- 15 business of insurance means:

- 17 (9.1) Surcharging any policy of insurance covering owner-

- occupied private residential properties or personal property of
- 2 <u>individuals that has been in force for sixty days due to an</u>
- 3 <u>unpreventable event resulting from a hurricane, tornado or</u>
- 4 storm. The provisions of this paragraph shall not be construed
- 5 to apply to an accident which is the result of any human factor
- 6 or influence.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
