## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 11, 1947 (P.L.538, No.246), entitled 2 "An act relating to the regulation of rates for insurance 3 which may be written by stock or mutual casualty insurance 4 companies, associations or exchanges, including fidelity, 5 surety and quaranty bonds and all other forms of motor vehicle insurance, and title insurance; to rating and advisory organizations; conferring on the Insurance Commissioner the power and duty of supervising and regulating 7 8 9 persons, associations, companies and corporations, and of 10 enforcing the provisions of this act; prescribing and regulating the practice and procedure before the 11 commissioner, and procedure for review by the courts; giving 12 the Court of Common Pleas of Dauphin County exclusive 13 jurisdiction over certain proceedings; prescribing penalties and providing for enforcement thereof, and repealing 14 15 inconsistent acts, " requiring insurers to publish rate 16 17 filings submitted to the Insurance Commissioner. 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 19 hereby enacts as follows: 20 Section 1. The act of June 11, 1947 (P.L.538, No.246), known 21 as The Casualty and Surety Rate Regulatory Act, is amended by 22 adding a section to read:
- 23 Section 9.1. Publication of Rate Filings.--Every insurer

- 1 shall provide notification of any rate filing submitted to the
- 2 <u>Insurance Commissioner and any rate filing approved by the</u>
- 3 <u>department</u>. The notification shall:
- 4 (1) Be provided through the use of newspaper
- 5 <u>publications and television stations.</u>
- 6 (2) Not be considered a public service announcement and
- 7 <u>the reasonable cost for the required notification shall be</u>
- 8 <u>the responsibility of the insurer.</u>
- 9 (3) For rate filings, require insurers to include the
- 10 <u>average percentage of premium increase per rating territory</u>
- that was requested and the date the filing was submitted. The
- 12 <u>required notification must:</u>
- (i) Be provided thirty (30) days prior to any rate
- 14 <u>approval consideration by the commissioner.</u>
- (ii) Include a statement that interested parties may
- 16 <u>submit written comment on the proposed rate filing to the</u>
- 17 commissioner specifying the full mailing address, and
- 18 that such comment must be submitted within the thirty
- 19 (30) days following the date the required notification is
- $\underline{\text{made.}}$
- 21 (4) For rate approvals, require insurers to include the
- 22 average percentage of the approved increase of premium per
- 23 rating territory and the effective date of the approval.
- 24 The newspaper publication and television station notifications
- 25 required under this section shall be in addition to any
- 26 notification currently provided in the Pennsylvania Bulletin and
- 27 by the commissioner.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
