AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 - Statutes, prohibiting operators from using handheld mobile
- 3 telephones.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3316. Prohibiting use of handheld mobile telephones.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), no
- 10 driver shall operate any moving vehicle on a highway of this
- 11 Commonwealth, which shall include Federal, State and municipal
- 12 highways, while using a handheld mobile telephone.
- 13 (b) Exception.--This section shall not apply to law
- 14 enforcement officers and operators of emergency vehicles when on
- 15 duty and acting in their official capacities.
- 16 (c) Defense.--It shall be a defense to a prosecution brought

- 1 for a violation of this section that the driver had reason to
- 2 <u>fear for the driver's safety, was reporting a traffic accident</u>
- 3 <u>or was making a "911" emergency call.</u>
- 4 (d) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 5 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 6 <u>a fine of \$250.</u>
- 7 (e) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 8 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 9 subsection:
- 10 <u>"Handheld mobile telephone." A mobile telephone other than a</u>
- 11 <u>hands-free mobile telephone with which a user engages in a call</u>
- 12 <u>using at least one hand.</u>
- 13 <u>"Hands-free mobile telephone." A mobile telephone that has</u>
- 14 an internal feature or function, or that is equipped with an
- 15 <u>attachment or addition, whether or not permanently part of such</u>
- 16 mobile telephone, by which a user engages in a call without the
- 17 use of either hand, whether or not the use of either hand is
- 18 necessary to activate, deactivate or initiate a function of such
- 19 telephone.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
