AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 20 (Decedents, Estates and Fiduciaries) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for access of
- 3 personal representative to electronic mail of decedent.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 20 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3333. Access to electronic mail.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- An electronic mail service provider shall
- 10 provide, to the personal representative of the estate of a
- 11 <u>deceased person who was domiciled in this Commonwealth at the</u>
- 12 time of the decedent's death, access to or copies of the
- 13 contents of the electronic mail account of the deceased person
- 14 upon receipt by the electronic mail service provider of:
- (1) a written request for access or copies made by the
- 16 personal representative, accompanied by a copy of the death
- 17 certificate and a certified copy of the certificate of

- 1 appointment as personal representative; or
- 2 (2) an order of the court that by law has jurisdiction
- 3 of the estate of the deceased person.
- 4 (b) Construction. -- Nothing in this section shall be
- 5 construed to require an electronic mail service provider to
- 6 <u>disclose any information in violation of any applicable Federal</u>
- 7 <u>law.</u>
- 8 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 9 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 10 <u>subsection</u>:
- 11 <u>"Electronic mail account." Any of the following:</u>
- 12 (1) Electronic mail sent or received by an end user of
- electronic mail services provided by an electronic mail
- 14 service provider that is stored or recorded by the electronic
- 15 <u>mail service provider in the regular course of providing</u>
- 16 services.
- 17 (2) Any other electronic information stored or recorded
- 18 by the electronic mail service provider that is directly
- 19 related to the electronic mail services provided to the end
- 20 <u>user by the electronic mail service provider, including, but</u>
- 21 <u>not limited to, billing and payment information.</u>
- 22 "Electronic mail service provider." Any person who:
- 23 (1) is an intermediary in sending or receiving
- 24 electronic mail; and
- 25 (2) provides to end users of electronic mail services
- the ability to send or receive electronic mail.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
