AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for work to be done under contract let on bid.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1714-B of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 1714-B. Mandate Waiver Program.--* * *
(o) Notwithstanding the provisions of the act of May 1, 1913 (P.L.155, No.104), referred to as the Separation Act, the department may approve a waiver of the provisions of section 751 that require separate contracts for the construction, reconstruction, repairs, maintenance or work of any other nature upon a school building, school property or a building or portion of a building leased under the provisions of section 703.1.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
