- 3 urging the Department of Education, local school districts
- 4 and intermediate units to participate in the 15th annual
- 5 Statewide Pennsylvania Academic Competition on April 21,
- 6 2006.
- 7 WHEREAS, The education of all Pennsylvania children is a
- 8 major concern to the citizens of this Commonwealth and requires
- 9 the use of creative and innovative means to focus attention upon
- 10 this concern; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Excellence displayed in athletic competition has
- 12 long been recognized by societal and community rewards provided
- 13 for that competition; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Academic competition is an innovative and creative

- 1 attempt to involve children, parents, educators and community
- 2 members in an educational forum for excellence; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Academic competition helps to hone the abilities and
- 4 intellectual skills of students, as well as providing
- 5 opportunities for incentives to continue the pursuit of
- 6 excellence in education; and
- 7 WHEREAS, A coordinated program of academic competition has
- 8 not existed in this Commonwealth, except in isolated school
- 9 district programs; therefore be it

- 17 Representatives Chamber on April 21, 2006.
