A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of September 2006 as "Ovarian Cancer
- 2 Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every woman is at risk for ovarian cancer regardless
- 4 of age, heritage or medical history; and
- 5 WHEREAS, A woman's risk of being diagnosed with ovarian
- 6 cancer is one in 58; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Breast cancer survivors, especially women 50 years
- 8 of age or older, have an even higher risk of developing ovarian
- 9 cancer; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that 22,500
- 2 women were diagnosed with ovarian cancer last year and 16,210
- 3 women died of the disease last year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Lack of awareness and education about ovarian cancer
- 5 is an important factor in late-stage diagnoses, which can cut
- 6 survival rates in half; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 8 month of September 2006 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in
- 9 Pennsylvania.
