## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April 19, 2006, as "Whole Foods Market Day" in  
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Whole Foods Market, founded in 1980 as one small  
4 store in Austin, Texas, is currently the world's leading  
5 retailer of natural and organic foods, with 180 stores in North  
6 America, including several stores in this Commonwealth, and the  
7 United Kingdom; and

8 WHEREAS, Whole Foods Market actively supports organic  
9 farming, which is the best method for promoting sustainable  
10 agriculture and protecting the environment and farm workers; and

11 WHEREAS, Through its local stores, Whole Foods Market  
12 supports food banks, sponsors neighborhood events, compensates  
13 its team members for community service work and contributes at  
14 least 5% of its total net profits to not-for-profit

1 organizations; therefore be it

2       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April

3 19, 2006, as "Whole Foods Market Day" in Pennsylvania.
