A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the heroism of Reading Police Officer Scott A. Wertz
- and noting with sadness his untimely death in the line of
- duty on August 6, 2006, at 40 years of age.
- 4 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz sustained fatal injuries in the line
- 5 of duty while working on a regional auto theft task force in
- 6 plain clothes in an unmarked police car in the City of Reading;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz and Officer Malcolm Eddinger were in
- 9 close proximity to the scene of an incident where a fight was

- 1 occurring at 2:06 a.m. and responded after hearing several shots
- 2 fired in the parking lot at 8th and Walnut Streets; and
- 3 WHEREAS, As the police officers approached the male suspect,
- 4 he ran from the scene, and Officer Wertz pursued him on foot,
- 5 closing in on the suspect who fired two shots at Officer Wertz,
- 6 striking him in the chest. Officer Eddinger then tackled and
- 7 apprehended the suspect; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz demonstrated his bravery and
- 9 professionalism and his commitment to law enforcement and
- 10 protecting the safety and welfare of his fellow citizens and
- 11 fellow officers on the night of his death and throughout his
- 12 nine years of service with the Reading Police Department; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz was a 1984 Wilson High School graduate
- 14 and 1994 Reading Police Academy graduate; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz received numerous commendations for
- 16 his anticrime endeavors and was widely recognized for his
- 17 efforts on behalf of the Police Athletic League; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz had previously served as a Berks
- 19 County Prison correctional officer and part-time police officer
- 20 in Sinking Spring Borough and South Heidelberg Township; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Officer Wertz resided in Spring Township with his
- 22 wife Tricia and sons Jared and Joshua; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the heroism
- 24 of Reading Police Officer Scott A. Wertz and note with sadness
- 25 his untimely death in the line of duty on August 6, 2006, at 40
- 26 years of age; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 28 the family of Reading Police Officer Scott A. Wertz.
