AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of October 10, 1974 (P.L.705, No.235), entitled 2 "An act providing for the training and licensing of watch
- guards, protective patrolmen, detectives and criminal
- 4 investigators, carrying and using lethal weapons in their
- 5 employment; imposing powers and duties on the Commissioner of
- 6 the Pennsylvania State Police; and providing penalties,"
- 7 further providing for certification.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 7 of the act of October 10, 1974
- 11 (P.L.705, No.235), known as the Lethal Weapons Training Act, is
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 Section 7. Certification and Fee. -- (a) A certification fee
- 14 of not more than fifteen dollars (\$15) shall be paid by each
- 15 individual satisfactorily completing the program prior to the
- 16 receipt of a certificate.
- 17 (b) The commissioner shall furnish to each individual
- 18 satisfactorily completing the program, an appropriate wallet or
- 19 billfold size copy of the certificate, which shall include a

- 1 photograph of the individual thereon.
- 2 (c) Every certified individual shall carry his wallet or
- 3 billfold size certificate on his person as identification during
- 4 the time when he is on duty or going to and from duty and
- 5 carrying a lethal weapon.
- 6 (d) Certification shall be for a period of five years,
- 7 <u>unless extended under subsection (f)</u>.
- 8 (e) Privately employed agents who, as an incidence to their
- 9 employment, carry a lethal weapon shall be required to renew
- 10 their certification within six months prior to the expiration of
- 11 their certificate. The commissioner shall prescribe the manner
- 12 in which the certification shall be renewed, and may charge a
- 13 nominal renewal fee therefore, not to exceed fifteen dollars
- 14 (\$15).
- (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
- 16 contrary, a certification under this act that is held by a
- 17 member of the United States Armed Forces or the Pennsylvania
- 18 National Guard on Federal active duty and deployed overseas and
- 19 that is scheduled to expire during the period of deployment
- 20 shall be extended until 90 days after the end of the deployment.
- 21 Possession of a certificate, together with a copy of the
- 22 person's military orders showing the dates of overseas
- 23 <u>deployment</u>, including the date that the overseas deployment
- 24 ends, shall constitute, during the extension period specified
- 25 <u>herein</u>, a defense to any charge filed pursuant to subsection (c)
- 26 or section 8(a).
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
