## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for network
- 3 modernization plans.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3014(h) of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3014. Network modernization plans.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (h) [Prohibition against political] Political subdivision
- 11 advanced and broadband services deployment. --
- 12 [(1) Except as otherwise provided for under paragraph
- 13 (2), a political subdivision or any entity established by a
- 14 political subdivision may not provide to the public for
- 15 compensation any telecommunications services, including
- 16 advanced and broadband services, within the service territory
- of a local exchange telecommunications company operating

under a network modernization plan.

3 broadband services if the political subdivision has submitted

(2) A political subdivision may offer advanced or

- 4 a written request for the deployment of such service to the
- 5 local exchange telecommunications company serving the area
- 6 and, within two months of receipt of the request, the local
- 7 exchange telecommunications company or one of its affiliates
- 8 has not agreed to provide the data speeds requested. If the
- 9 local exchange telecommunications company or one of its
- 10 affiliates agrees to provide the data speeds requested, then
- it must do so within 14 months of receipt of the request.
- 12 (3) The prohibition in paragraph (1) shall not be
- 13 construed to preclude the continued provision or offering of
- 14 telecommunications services by a political subdivision of the
- same type and scope as were being provided on the effective
- 16 date of this section.]
- 17 (4) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, a
- 18 political subdivision or any entity established by a
- 19 political subdivision may provide to the public for
- 20 <u>compensation any telecommunications services, including</u>
- 21 <u>advanced and broadband services, within the service territory</u>
- of a local exchange telecommunications company operating
- 23 under a network modernization plan, on and after the
- 24 effective date of this paragraph.
- 25 (5) Nothing in paragraph (4) shall be construed to
- 26 <u>preclude the continued provision or offering of</u>
- 27 telecommunications services by a political subdivision of the
