## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for restoration of operating privilege.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1545 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1545. Restoration of operating privilege.
9	Upon the restoration of any person's operating privilege
10	which has been suspended or revoked pursuant to this subchapter
11	or pursuant to Chapter 38 (relating to driving after imbibing
12	alcohol or utilizing drugs), such person's record shall show
13	five points, except that any additional points assessed against
14	the person since the date of the last violation resulting in the
15	suspension or revocation shall be added to such five points
16	unless the person has served an additional period of suspension
17	or revocation pursuant to section 1544(a) (relating to

additional period of revocation or suspension). This section
shall not apply to section <u>1532(d)</u> (relating to suspension of
<u>operating privilege</u>), 1533 (relating to suspension of operating
privilege for failure to respond to citation) or to 18 Pa.C.S. §
6310.4 (relating to restriction of operating privileges).
Section 2. This act shall take effect in <del>60</del> 90 days.
