- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 6124 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- Erection of traffic-control devices at intersections.
- 9 The department on State-designated highways, including
- intersections with local highways, and local authorities on 10
- 11 intersections of highways under their jurisdiction may erect and
- maintain stop signs, yield signs or other official traffic-12
- 13 control devices to designate through highways or to designate
- intersections at which vehicular traffic on one or more of the 14
- 15 roadways should yield or stop and yield before entering the
- intersection. An engineering and traffic investigation is not 16

- 1 required for local authorities to erect and maintain stop signs
- 2 <u>in a residence district if the roadway:</u>
- (1) is not a numbered traffic route; and 3
- (2) is functionally classified by the department as a 4
- 5 local highway.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
