9	(a) Sexually violent predatorsA person subject to the
10	registration requirements of section 9795.1 (relating to
11	registration) and classified as a sexually violent predator
12	shall not intentionally or knowingly enter into an area within
13	one mile of a school, playground, park or day-care center.
14	(b) Other offendersAll other persons subject to the
15	registration requirements of section 9795.1 shall not

1 intentionally or knowingly enter into an area within 2,000 feet

- 2 <u>of a school, playground, park or day-care center.</u>
- (c) Grading. -- An offense under subsection (a) or (b) 3
- 4 constitutes a felony of the third degree.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
