## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 27, 1961 (P.L.1700, No.699), entitled "An act relating to the regulation of the practice 3 of pharmacy, including the sales, use and distribution of drugs and devices at retail; and amending, revising, 4 5 consolidating and repealing certain laws relating thereto," 6 further providing for unlawful acts. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 8 of the act of September 27, 1961 10 (P.L.1700, No.699), known as the Pharmacy Act, is amended by 11 adding a paragraph to read: 12 Section 8. Unlawful Acts. -- It shall be unlawful for: 13 14 (14.2) Any pharmacist to refuse to dispense or refill a 15 prescription solely on the grounds that dispensing or refilling 16 the prescription would contravene the pharmacist's philosophical, moral or religious beliefs. 17 18

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
