AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing, in vocational education, for definitions and for payments on account of pupils enrolled in vocational curriculums. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1801(4) of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended to read: 13 Section 1801. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases 14 as used in this article shall, unless a different meaning is 15 plainly required by the context, have the following meanings: 16 "Vocational agricultural education" shall mean that form 17

- 14 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the
- 15 contrary, vocational agricultural education programs operated by
- 16 <u>school districts and area vocational-technical schools shall</u>
- 17 receive funding in accordance with this section regardless of
- 18 any minimum time requirements for class hours established by
- 19 regulation of the State Board of Vocational Education or
- 20 regulation or standards of the Department of Education.
- 21 (g) Vocational education credits may be given for hours
- 22 spent in supervised agricultural experience and cooperative and
- 23 clinical experiences.
- Section 3. The provisions of 22 Pa. Code § 339.22(a)(4)
- 25 (relating to program content) are abrogated to the extent of any
- 26 inconsistency with this act.
- 27 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
