- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in rules of the road in general, further providing
- 3 for special speed limitations.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3365(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3365. Special speed limitations.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (b) School zones.--
- 11 (1) When passing through a school zone as defined and
- 12 established under regulations of the department, no person
- 13 shall drive a vehicle at a speed greater than 15 miles per
- 14 hour. An official traffic-control device shall indicate the
- beginning and end of each school zone to traffic approaching
- in each direction. Establishment of a school zone, including
- its location and hours of operation, shall be approved by the

- 1 department.
- (2) The department shall approve and establish a school 2
- zone for any educational or child-care facility that was a 3
- 4 former school and that otherwise satisfies the requirements
- 5 of a school zone under the regulations of the department
- 6 applicable to schools.
- 7 (3) For purposes of this subsection, a school includes
- any grade between pre-kindergarten through grade 12, 8
- 9 inclusive.

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
