7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 301(a) of the act of November 10, 1999
10	(P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code
11	Act, is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
12	Section 301. Adoption by regulations.
13	(a) Regulations
14	* * *
15	(11) Regulations under this subsection shall include the
16	requirement that hotels, motels and boarding houses which are
17	classified as group R-1 occupancies, have carbon monoxide
18	sensor devices of a type specified by the department in each

1	sleeping unit. The regulations shall include a procedure for
2	building owners to request an exemption from the carbon
3	monoxide sensor device requirement if the owner can
4	demonstrate that there is no potential for carbon monoxide
5	poisoning in the building.

7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
