1 2	Designating May 12, 2007, as "Disability Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, According to the United States Census Bureau,

7	Heart disease - 71.3 million people

11	WHEREAS, The majority of disabilities affecting

noninstitutionalized persons with disabilities falls within the 16 to 64 age group and impairs 2.3 million people, and another 3 1.4 million noninstitutionalized persons with disabilities are 65 years of age or older; and 5 WHEREAS, Persons with disabilities contribute to the 6 economic, educational and social growth of this Commonwealth; 7 and 9 mersons with disabilities are 9 determined by the billion of this commonwealth; 9 and 9 mersons are billion billion of the social growth gro
