- 5 WHEREAS, The tight-knit community of the Virginia Tech campus
- 6 in Blacksburg, Virginia, was devastated by an unthinkable
- 7 tragedy on April 16, 2007, when a gunman killed 32 students and
- 8 faculty members in the worst mass shooting in United States
- 9 history; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The family and friends of the victims, as well as
- 11 all members of the Virginia Tech family, are in a period of
- 12 great mourning and need our support and prayers during this very
- 13 difficult time; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania offer its heartfelt condolences to

- 1 the victims and their family and friends who have been deeply
- 2 affected by these tragic events; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives express hope that
- 4 losses caused by this great tragedy will lead to a shared
- 5 national sense of reconciliation and a commitment to take the
- 6 steps necessary to prevent such tragedies in the future; and be

- 9 Virginia Tech has served as an exemplary institution of higher
