University of Scranton, and as an executive board member of the 1 Boys and Girls Club of Scranton, the Pennsylvania Regional 2 Tissue and Transplant Bank, Scranton Area Foundation, Greater 3 Scranton Chamber of Commerce and the Scranton Club; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Professionally, Mr. Kane has been honored by the United States Small Business Administration and by the Greater 6 Scranton Chamber of Commerce, was a State director of the 7 Pennsylvania Motor Truck Association and has been affiliated 8 with the American Warehousemen's Association, American Trucking 9 Association and the Council of Logistics Management; and 10 11 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Kane and his wife, the former Joan Flynn, have eight children and 22 grandchildren; and 12 13 WHEREAS, It is fitting to designate a day to honor a man who has made such contributions to the economy of this Commonwealth, 14 15 who has been such an exemplary community servant and who has 16 demonstrated great leadership as a husband and father; therefore be it 17
