- 1 Honoring the memory of the law enforcement officers who gave
  - their lives in the line of duty in this Commonwealth and
- 3 recognizing the memorial service in their honor in Soldiers'
- 4 Grove at the State Capitol Complex on May 5, 2008.

- 5 WHEREAS, Officer Walter Barclay of the Philadelphia Police
- 6 Department made the ultimate sacrifice on August 19, 2007; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Officer Scott Ball of the Pennsylvania State Police
- 8 made the ultimate sacrifice on August 27, 2007; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Officer Charles Cassidy of the Philadelphia Police
- 10 Department made the ultimate sacrifice on November 1, 2007; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The deaths of these law enforcement officers make a

- 1 total of 702 officers who, through the year 2007, made the
- 2 ultimate sacrifice since the beginning of law enforcement within
- 3 this Commonwealth; and
- 4 WHEREAS, A Venango County constable who died in April 1825 is
- 5 believed to be the first officer to have given his life in the
- 6 line of duty in this Commonwealth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, "National Police Memorial Day" is held on May 15
- 8 each year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The week containing May 15, is celebrated each year
- 10 as "National Police Week"; and
- 11 WHEREAS, On October 1, 1962, Joint Resolution 730 of the 87th
- 12 Congress of the United States was signed, authorizing the
- 13 President to proclaim May 15 of each year as "Peace Officers
- 14 Memorial Day"; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Twenty years passed before the first "National
- 16 Police Memorial Day" was recognized on May 15, 1982; and
- 17 WHEREAS, May 15 has continued to be observed annually in
- 18 memory of those police officers who made the ultimate sacrifice
- 19 in the line of duty; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Lodge of the Fraternal Order
- 21 of Police presents the annual memorial service in this
- 22 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the
- 24 memories of Officer Walter Barclay, Officer Scott Ball and
- 25 Officer Charles Cassidy, the law enforcement officers who gave
- 26 their lives in the line of duty in this Commonwealth in 2007,
- 27 and recognize the memorial service in their honor in Soldiers'
- 28 Grove at the State Capitol Complex on May 5, 2008.
