AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for use of laser sighting device by blind
3 hunter.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Chapter 23 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

8 SUBCHAPTER C.1

13 (a) Hunting.--A blind hunter may use a laser sighting device
14 during regular hunting hours when assisted by a person who:

15 (1) is not legally blind;

16 (2) has a hunting license; and

17 (3) is at least 13 years of age.

18 (b) Proof.--A blind hunter must carry proof of being blind.

1 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
3 subsection:

4 "Blind hunter." The term shall have the same meaning as the
5 term "blind person" in section 2221 of the act of April 9, 1929
6 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
