A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for marriage between one man and one woman.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
б	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 29. Marriage.</u>
10	<u>No union other than a marriage between one man and one woman</u>
11	shall be valid or recognized as marriage or the functional
12	equivalent of marriage by the Commonwealth.
13	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
14	Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
15	Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
16	comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
17	XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the

required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

4 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 5 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 6 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 7 8 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 9 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 10 11 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 12 13 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 14 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 15 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 16 17 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 18 passed by the General Assembly.
