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(g) Reserve component of armed forces hunting licenses .--8 (1) Reserve component of the armed forces hunting 9 licenses shall be issued by the commission or county treasurer to any person otherwise eligible for a resident 10 11 hunting license in this Commonwealth who provides 12 documentation that within the previous 24 months the person 13 was deployed overseas as a member of the reserve component of the armed forces pursuant to 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to 14 15 definitions) for a period of [180] 60 consecutive days or more or was released early from service because of an injury 16 17 or disease incurred in the line of duty. Only one hunting 18 license under this subsection may be issued for each 19 qualifying deployment of a person applying for the license. \* \* \* 20

§ 2709. License costs and fees. 21

22 (a) License costs. -- Any person who qualifies under the provisions of this chapter shall be issued the applicable 23 license upon payment of the following costs and the issuing 24 agent's fee: 25
