## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating November 8, 2008, as "Charles Demuth Day" in
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, World-renowned artist and Pennsylvania native,
- 4 Charles Demuth was born on November 8, 1883, and he specialized
- 5 in painting water colors and, later in life, switched to oil
- 6 painting, developing a style of painting known as Precisionism
- 7 or Cubist Realism; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Demuth family has a Germanic heritage and, upon
- 9 arrival in the United States, they settled in Bethlehem; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Demuth's great-great-great-grandfather moved to
- 11 Lancaster and started a small tobacco shop on East King Street;
- 12 and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Demuth was born in Lancaster, and he grew up in
- 14 a house next to the tobacco shop; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Demuth graduated from Franklin & Marshall
- 16 Academy and thereafter studied at Drexel University and the
- 17 Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts in Philadelphia and at the

- 1 Julian Academy in Paris, France; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Although plagued by illness all of his life, Mr.
- 3 Demuth produced more than one thousand works of art, including
- 4 the well-known "My Egypt," which was inspired by grain elevators
- 5 in Lancaster; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Despite studying and painting in Philadelphia, New
- 7 York, Provincetown, Paris and Bermuda, Mr. Demuth created most
- 8 of his work at his home in Lancaster in a second-floor studio
- 9 overlooking his mother's garden, which remains a garden today;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, Today, the 18th century properties on East King
- 12 Street in Lancaster are among the oldest properties in America
- 13 and the Demuth Home, which once served as a Colonial-era tavern,
- 14 now houses the Demuth Museum, the Demuth Archives and Library,
- 15 as well as some of the Demuth Art Collection; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Demuth Tobacco Shop, founded in 1770, is the
- 17 oldest, continuously operated tobacco shop in the United States;
- 18 and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Demuth's artwork has been on display at art
- 20 museums all over the world, including the New York Museum of
- 21 Modern Art, the National Museum of Modern Art in France and the
- 22 Whitney Museum of American Art in New York City; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate November 8, 2008, the
- 24 125th anniversary of his birth, as "Charles Demuth Day" in
- 25 Pennsylvania.
