AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An 2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 4 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 10 penalties," further providing for exclusion from the sales 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 204 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, 15 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding a clause to read: 16 17 Section 204. Exclusions from Tax. -- The tax imposed by 18 section 202 shall not be imposed upon any of the following: 19

(67) The sale at retail or use of a compact fluorescent lamp

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- 1 (CFL), also known as a compact fluorescent light bulb or energy-
- 2 <u>saving light bulb.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
