AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting the use of full Social Security numbers on State forms.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Social
- 7 Security Number Prohibition Act.
- 8 Section 2. Use of full Social Security numbers prohibited.
- 9 Except as required by Federal law or regulation and except as
- 10 provided in section 3 and notwithstanding any other law to the
- 11 contrary, no person shall be required to provide more than the
- 12 last four digits of his Social Security number on any form
- 13 required by a State governmental entity.
- 14 Section 3. Exceptions.

- 1 This act shall not apply to:
- 2 (1) Forms required by the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,
- No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971.
- 4 (2) Any other form utilized in connection with the
- 5 collection of State taxes.
- 6 Section 4. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
