AN ACT

1 Amending the act of November 22, 1978 (P.L.1166, No.274),
2 entitled "An act establishing the Pennsylvania Commission on
3 Crime and Delinquency, providing for its powers and duties
4 establishing several advisory committees within the
5 commission and providing for their powers and duties,"
6 further providing for the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime
7 and Delinquency.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 2(b) of the act of November 22, 1978
11 (P.L.1166, No.274), referred to as the Pennsylvania Commission
12 on Crime and Delinquency Law, amended June 22, 2001 (P.L.396,
13 No.30), is amended to read:

14 Section 2. Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency.

15 * * *

16 (b) Composition.--The commission shall consist of the
17 following members:

18 (1) The Attorney General.

19 (2) The Chief Justice of Pennsylvania.

1 (3) The Court Administrator of Pennsylvania.

2 (4) A judge of a court of common pleas.

3 (5) Commissioner of State Police.

4 (6) The chairmen of the House and Senate Majority
5 Appropriations Committees.

6 (7) The chairman of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency
7 Prevention Committee.

8 (8) Four members of the General Assembly, of whom one
9 shall be designated by, and serve at the pleasure of the
10 President pro tempore of the Senate, one by the Minority
11 Leader of the Senate, one by the Speaker of the House of
12 Representatives and one by the Minority Leader of the House
13 of Representatives.

14 (9) Seven members appointed by the Governor, one
15 representative of local law enforcement agencies, one
16 representative of local correctional facilities, one
17 representative of local elected officials, one district
18 attorney representative, one representative of county
19 sheriffs, one representative of a local victims' service
20 agency and one representative of county commissioners.

21 (10) Seven private citizens appointed by the Governor,
22 at least two of which serve on the Juvenile Justice and
23 Delinquency Prevention Committee.

24 (11) Secretary of Corrections.

25 (12) The Victim Advocate.

26 (13) Secretary of Public Welfare.

27 (14) Secretary of Education.

28 (15) Secretary of Health.

29 (16) Chairman of the Board of Probation and Parole.

30 (17) Executive Director of the Juvenile Court Judges'

Commission.

(18) Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Commission
on Sentencing.

[(18)] (19) Such additional members appointed by the
Governor as are necessary to implement programs authorized by
State and Federal law.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
