AN ACT

Amending the act of November 22, 1978 (P.L.1166, No.274), entitled "An act establishing the Pennsylvania Commission on 2 Crime and Delinquency, providing for its powers and duties 3 establishing several advisory committees within the commission and providing for their powers and duties," 5 further providing for the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency. 15 16 (b) Composition. -- The commission shall consist of the following members: 17 18 (1)The Attorney General.

- 14 Seven members appointed by the Governor, one 15 representative of local law enforcement agencies, one representative of local correctional facilities, one 16 17 representative of local elected officials, one district 18 attorney representative, one representative of county 19 sheriffs, one representative of a local victims' service 20 agency and one representative of county commissioners.
- Seven private citizens appointed by the Governor, 22 at least two of which serve on the Juvenile Justice and 23 Delinquency Prevention Committee.
