5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 708(a) of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
8	§ 708. Executive sessions.
9	(a) PurposeAn agency may hold an executive session for
10	one or more of the following reasons:
11	* * *
12	(7) To discuss or plan matters related to safety and
13	security which if disclosed would jeopardize the integrity of
14	the agency's safety or security operation or reveal
15	vulnerability assessments, risks, specific targets or
16	specific emergency or security procedures or codes.

18	Section 2. Section 714 of Title 65 is amended to read:

1 § 714. Penalty.

2 Any member of any agency who participates in a meeting with the intent and purpose by that member of violating this chapter 3 commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be 4 sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding [\$100] <u>\$1,000</u> plus costs 5 of prosecution[.] for a first offense and a fine not exceeding 6 \$2,000 plus costs of prosecution for a second or subsequent_ 7 offense. An agency shall not make a payment on behalf of or 8 9 reimburse a member of an agency for a fine or cost resulting from the member's violation of this section. 10

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
