AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in penalties and disposition of fines, providing  
3 for local police service surcharge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 6508. Local police service surcharge.

9 (a) Levy and imposition.--In addition to any fines, fees,  
10 penalties or surcharges levied or imposed as provided by law,  
11 under this title or any other statute, a surcharge of \$10 shall  
12 be levied upon conviction of any violation of this title, for  
13 disposition in accordance with subsection (b).

14 (b) Disposition.--Notwithstanding the provisions of 42  
15 Pa.C.S. §§ 3571 (relating to Commonwealth portion of fines,  
16 etc.) and 3573 (relating to municipal corporation portion of  
17 fines, etc.), a surcharge levied and collected under subsection  
18 (a) by any division of the unified judicial system existing

1 under section 1 of Article V of the Constitution of Pennsylvania  
2 and 42 Pa.C.S. § 301 (relating to unified judicial system) shall  
3 be:

4       (1) remitted to the municipal corporation in which the  
5 offense occurred, provided the municipal corporation has or  
6 participates in a local or regional police force, and shall  
7 be used exclusively by the municipal corporation for the  
8 support of that local or regional police force; or

9       (2) in the event the municipal corporation in which the  
10 offense occurred does not have or participate in a local or  
11 regional police force, remitted to the Commonwealth for  
12 credit to the General Fund.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
