## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, further providing for limitation on the regulation 3 of firearms and ammunition. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6120 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 6120. Limitation on the regulation of firearms and 10 ammunition. 11 12 (a.2) Remedies for unlawful regulation. -- Notwithstanding any 13 other provision of law, upon finding that a county, municipality 14 or township in any manner regulated the lawful ownership, 15 possession, transfer or transportation of firearms, ammunition

or ammunition components in violation of subsection (a) or 53

- 1 Pa.C.S. § 2962(g) (relating to limitation on municipal powers),
- 2 <u>a court shall direct the county, municipality or township to pay</u>
- 3 <u>actual damages and reasonable attorney fees and costs to a party</u>
- 4 who successfully challenges the regulation.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
