## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of December 15, 1988 (P.L.1235, No.151), entitled "An act providing for the establishment of the Children's Trust Fund, for a governing board and for the powers and duties of the board; and prescribing the powers and duties of certain State agencies," further providing for the Children's Trust Fund.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 8 of the act of December 15, 1988
10	(P.L.1235, No.151), known as the Children's Trust Fund Act,
11	amended May 31, 1990 (P.L.208, No.43), is amended to read:
12	Section 8. Children's Trust Fund created.
13	There is hereby imposed a [\$10] <u><math>\$35</math></u> surcharge on all
14	applications for marriage licenses and <u>a \$25 surcharge</u> on all
15	divorce complaints. These surcharges shall be paid into a
16	special nonlapsing Children's Trust Fund, which is established
17	for the purposes described in this act. Funding for existing or
18	ongoing services of State or local agencies shall not be

- 1 replaced by the trust fund.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
