AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for learners' permits.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 1505(d) and (e) of Title 75 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 7 § 1505. Learners' permits.
- 8 * * *
- 9 (d) Duration of permit. -- A learner's permit shall be valid
- 10 for a period of one year after date of issue, or until the
- 11 holder of the permit has failed the examination as authorized in
- 12 section 1508 (relating to examination of applicant for driver's
- 13 license) three times within the one-year period. A motorcycle
- 14 <u>learner's permit shall not be renewable after one year. A person</u>
- 15 may reapply for a motorcycle learner's permit no more frequently
- 16 than three times in a ten-year period.
- 17 (e) Authorization to test for driver's license and junior

- 1 driver's license.--A person with a learner's permit is
- 2 authorized to take the examination for a regular or junior
- 3 driver's license for the class of vehicle for which a permit is
- 4 held. Before a person under the age of 18 years may take the
- 5 examination for a junior driver's license, including a Class M
- 6 <u>license to operate a motorcycle</u>, the minor must:
- 7 (1) Have held a learner's permit for that class of vehicle for a period of six months.
- 9 Present to the department a certification form 10 signed by the father, mother, guardian, person in loco 11 parentis or spouse of a married minor stating that the minor 12 applicant has completed 50 hours of practical driving 13 experience accompanied as required under subsection (b). 14 Submission of a certification shall not subject the parent, 15 quardian, person in loco parentis or spouse of a married 16 minor to any liability based upon the certification.
- 17 (3) Have the certification form completed when the minor
 18 is ready for the licensing examination. The certification
 19 form shall be developed by the department and will be
 20 provided by the department when the original application for
 21 a learner's permit is processed. The department will make
 22 this form readily available through the mail or electronic
 23 means.
- 24 <u>(4) Complete the department-approved motorcycle safety</u>
 25 <u>course as a requirement for obtaining a Class M junior</u>
- 26 <u>driver's license.</u>

- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
