## AN ACT

14	an offense if he knowingly fails to:
15	(1) register with the Pennsylvania State Police as
16	required under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9795.2 (relating to registration

2 (2) verify his address or be photographed as required
3 under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9796 (relating to verification of
4 residence); or

5 (3) provide accurate information when registering under
6 42 Pa.C.S. § 9795.2 or verifying an address under 42 Pa.C.S.

9 (c) Grading for sexually violent predators and others with 10 lifetime registration.--

11 (2) Except as set forth in paragraph (3), an individual 12 subject to registration under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9795.1(b)(1), (2) 13 [or], (3) and (4) who commits a violation of subsection (a) 14 (1) or (2) commits a felony of the second degree.

(3) An individual subject to registration under 42
Pa.C.S. § 9795.1(b)(1), (2) [or], (3) and (4) who commits a
violation of subsection (a)(1) or (2) and who has previously
been convicted of an offense under subsection (a)(1) or (2)
or a similar offense commits a felony of the first degree.
(4) An individual subject to registration under 42

Pa.C.S. § 9795.1(b)(1), (2) [or], (3) <u>and (4)</u> who violates subsection (a)(3) commits a felony of the first degree. \* \* \*
