AN ACT

1	Amending the act of July 2, 1993 (P.L.359, No.50), entitled "An
2	act providing for the establishment, operation and

6	authorizing the incurring of indebtedness, with the approval
7	of the electorate, to provide funding for the acquisition of,

9	facilities, educational facilities, historic sites, zoos and
10	public libraries; imposing additional powers and duties on
11	the Department of Environmental Resources, the Department of

19	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
20	hereby enacts as follows:
21	Section 1. Section 9 of the act of July 2, 1993 (P.L.359,
22	No.50), known as the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation
23	Fund Act, is amended to read:
24	Section 9. Annual reports.
25	[Beginning on January 31, 1995, and annually] No later than

1 July 1, 2009, and each July 1 thereafter, the Department of 2 [Environmental Resources, the Department of Community Affairs,] 3 Conservation and Natural Resources, the Department of Education, the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission[,] and the 4 State System of Higher Education[, the Pennsylvania Fish and 5 Boat Commission and the Pennsylvania Game Commission] shall <u>each</u> 6 7 submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual report 8 of projects and services provided by [funding from this act.] moneys from the fund. For grants awarded from the fund, the 9 annual report shall, at a minimum, include the following: the 10 name of the applicant, location and description of the project, 11 12 total project costs, the amount requested, any matching funds 13 provided by the applicant, anticipated project completion GRANT 14 CONTRACT EXPIRATION date and the amount granted. Each department and agency shall publish and maintain the annual report on the 15 department's or agency's publicly accessible Internet website. 16 17 At the discretion of the department and agency, the annual 18 report required under this section may be submitted to the 19 Governor and the General Assembly by electronic mail. 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
