## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other offenses, further providing for the offense of greyhound racing. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 7516 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 § 7516. Greyhound racing and simulcasting. 8 9 (a) Racing. -- A person who holds, conducts or operates a 10 greyhound race for public exhibition in this Commonwealth for 11 monetary remuneration commits a misdemeanor of the first degree. 12 (b) Simulcasting. A person who transmits 13 (B) SIMULCASTING. --14 (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT TRANSMIT OR RECEIVE interstate or 15 intrastate simulcasting of a greyhound race in this 16 Commonwealth for monetary remuneration commits a misdemeanor 17 of the first degree. 18 (2) A COURT OF COMMON PLEAS MAY IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY

- OF UP TO \$10,000 UPON ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
